

2016 NEW YORK STATE FAIR LIVESTOCK ARRIVAL TIME SCHEDULE

IMPORTANT ARRIVAL INFORMATION

These rules affect all livestock and horses

- A. All **OPEN HORSES** must enter gate #5. Once unloaded, exit gate #5 then reenter at gate #7 and proceed to gate #11. Continue straight on perimeter road, turn left at State Police Barracks follow signage to the Livestock parking area. To reload at end of show exit at gate #10, proceed to gate #6 and re-enter at gate #5. Take a left to barns, load horses then exit gate #5 to leave Fair.
- B. All **SHEEP, GOATS, LLAMAS** have a new inspection station. It is now located just inside gate #7 past the state troopers check point. Once inspected proceed to gate #11, turn left on Belle Isle and go to barns.
- C. **BEEF, SWINE AND 4-H HORSES** enter gate #7, proceed to gate #11 NOT gate #10 (gate #10 is becoming an exit only gate), turn left on Belle Isle and go to barns.
- D. All **LIVESTOCK EXCEPT OPEN HORSES** once unloaded are to proceed back down Belle Isle, and follow signage to the Livestock parking area.

4-H & OPEN CLASS DAIRY CATTLE ARRIVALS

Holstein , Red & White and Milking Shorthorn Cattle - From **9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.** on Wed. August 24. Colored Breeds - From **12:01 a.m., Wed. morning, August 31 until 9:00 a.m., Wed., August 31.**

4-H & OPEN CLASS BEEF CATTLE ARRIVALS

First Rotation may arrive between 11:00 a.m. & 10:00 p.m., Wed, Aug. 24 or in place by 9:30 a.m.. Thurs, Aug. 25.

Second Rotation may arrive between 6:00 p.m. & 10:00 p.m. on Sun., Aug. 28 or be in place by 9:30 a.m., Mon., Aug. 29.

Third Rotation may arrive between 6:00 p.m. & 10:00 p.m. on Thurs., Sept. 1 or be in place by 9:30 a.m., Fri., Sept. 2.

4-H DAIRY & MEAT GOAT ARRIVALS

Any time between 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 mid. on Wed., Aug. 24 & 6:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. on Thurs., Aug. 25. Late arrivals by written permission from the 4-H Superintendent.

YOUTH SHEEP ARRIVALS

Between the hours of 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 mid., Wed., Aug. 24 & between 6:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. on Thurs., Aug. 25. Any other time, **must be by written permission** from 4-H Superintendent.

NEW 4-H SWINE ARRIVALS

Between the hours of 8:30 p.m. – until 12:00 midnight on Sat., Aug. 27 and 6:00 am - 9:00 a.m. on Sun., Aug. 28.

OPEN DAIRY GOATS

Arrival time is between 12:01 a.m. & 9:00 a.m., Wed., Aug. 31. Before unloading at Goat Barn, the Goat Superintendent must be presented a signed Livestock Entry Permit issued at Vet Check Station.

OPEN MEAT GOATS

Arrival time is between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Friday, September 2. Before unloading at Goat Barn, the Goat Superintendent must be presented a signed Livestock Entry Permit issued at Vet Check Station.

OPEN SHEEP

Arrival time is between Tues., Aug. 30 from 12:00 mid. and 10:00 a.m., Wed., Aug. 31. Any other time, **must be by written permission** from Open Sheep Superintendent.

OPEN SWINE

Arrival time is Wed., Aug. 31 from 10:00 p.m. until 12:00 mid. & Thurs., Sept. 1 from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

LLAMAS

Arrival time is between 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 mid. on Wed., Aug. 24 & 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m., Thurs., Aug. 25.

Livestock trucks & transport vehicles arriving at other than designated times may experience delays while awaiting vets at check in station, as well as an escort to unloading area. An escort fee may be assessed on vehicles arriving during Fair operating hours at other than arrival/release time periods specified. Map shows the traffic routes for livestock trucks.

4-H & OPEN CLASS DAIRY CATTLE RELEASE

On release days (Tues., August 30 & Mon., September 5) dairy cattle trucks will line up before 12:01 a.m. in single file on Rodeo Drive in the order of the zone letter provided. (Rodeo Drive runs along the front of the Fairgrounds between the exterior fence & the railroad tracks). Release numbers will be assigned by the Superintendent & the release permit will be authenticated by the Superintendent's staff before access to the Fairgrounds is permitted. Trucks without proper validation **will not be allowed to enter the Fairgrounds. There will be no exceptions!!**

There will be a designated truck parking area. See the marked route in the centerfold.

On Tues., August 29 general release of Open & 4-H Holstein, Red & White and Milking Shorthorn show cattle will be by appointment only. All First Shift show cattle are to be removed from the Fairgrounds by 8:00 a.m. on Tues., August 29.

Mon., September 5, Labor Day, Second Shift release will be by appointment. & must be departed by 10:00 a.m. on Mon., Sept. 5, unless there are extenuating circumstances which will be discussed with the Superintendents.

YOUTH SHEEP, SWINE & GOAT RELEASE

Youth Sheep entered in 4-H will be released at 6:00 p.m., Tues., August 30.

Youth Sheep entered in Open Class will be released at 6:00 p.m., Sun., September 4. **Sheep entered in the Open Class Show that were not shown in the Youth Show may not leave until they are released by the Open Superintendent on Mon., Sept. 5.**

4-H Dairy & Meat Goats will be released at 7:00 p.m., Tues., August 30 & must be removed by 10:00 p.m. **No youth meat goats are to remain on the fairgrounds.**

4-H Hogs released at 7:00 p.m., Wed, August 31.

OPEN CLASS SHEEP, SWINE & DAIRY & MEAT GOAT RELEASE

General Release will be between 5:00 p.m. & 12:00 mid. Mon., Sept. 5.

Open Goat Release will be in accordance with Zone Map.

OPEN CLASS LLAMA RELEASE

Between the hours of 1:00 p.m. & 5:00 pm. on Sat., Aug. 27.

OPEN & 4-H BEEF CATTLE RELEASE

First Rotation beef breeds will be released under the direction of the Beef Cattle Superintendent at 4:00 p.m. on Sun., Aug. 28.

Second Rotation beef breeds will be released at 4:00 p.m., Thurs., Sept. 1.

Third Rotation beef breeds will be released at 3:00 p.m., Mon., Sept. 5.
