

DRAFT HORSE PERFORMANCE DIVISIONS

USE BLUE ENTRY BLANK

All hitch classes, except cart and tandem classes, will be shown to fifth-wheel wagons.

Draft and commercial vehicles; purebred or grade horses, to be shown in harness before a suitable working vehicle. One driver only and one attendant on wagon. Driver and attendant to be properly attired. In double-line classes, passengers should be capable drivers. **No passengers under the age of 10.** Management reserves the right to refuse to allow any hitch to enter any class and/or to allow the judge to excuse any hitch from any class without being liable for any compensation of any kind.

In the event management determines that it is in the best interest of the horse show to split classes in this division, premium money and added money will be reallocated. If there are fewer than three entries in any section, it may be combined with another section.

Juniors may drive geldings or mares only. Accompanying adults should remain on the cart or wagon at all times in the Youth classes. If a header is required, another person, from outside the ring should come in to head the entry.

Headers must wear ties and jackets or other appropriate attire. No Blue Jeans In The Arena Please!

Headers are encouraged in all hitch classes, however no one will be permitted to stand inside the ring during the performance.

All scratches must be made in the upstairs show office two hours prior to the start of the session.

Once the gate has been closed on a class, it will not be reopened for late arrivals.

In the event of a lost shoe outside the show ring, the Show Manager will determine whether the gate can be held or not. If the shoe is lost in the ring, the entry may request a time out to replace the shoe. The farrier will have five minutes to complete the task.

Each hitch may participate only ONCE. Four of the horses in any Six Horse Hitch must be owned by the same exhibitor or family. Usual hitch presentation standards apply in this class.

Every hitch will be required to work individually for 4 minutes. Hitches will be judged on their ability to perform a minimum of four maneuvers within the allotted time. Hitches that work for less than 3.5 minutes or exceed 4.5 minutes will be penalized accordingly. Electric timers will be used. The electric eye will be at the in-gate. A horn will sound after 3.5 minutes to notify the driver of elapsed time, and will sound again after 4.5 minutes to notify the Judge that scoring has ceased. A numerical score will be announced for each hitch upon completion of the drive. The top four hitches must return for awards. **If Exhibitors Provide Music On A CD or DVD To The Show Announcer Prior To The Class, The Music Will Be Played During Their Performance.**

YOUTH MUST COMPETE IN AT LEAST FOUR CLASSES TO BE ELIGIBLE.

If any youth classes are combined, all youth will be placed and each exhibitor will earn points in his/her age group. The highest placing youth in each age group will earn 1st place points and so forth.

In the event of a tie, the exhibitor winning the most blue ribbons will be declared the Champion. If a tie still remains, the exhibitor placing higher than the greatest number of competitors will be the Champion.
