

OPEN PONY IN HEAVY HARNESS DIVISION

1. Only the driver and one groom will be allowed on a vehicle. No animal will be allowed on a vehicle. All Ponies Must Be DRAFT Type.
2. Only one attendant per entry will be allowed in the ring. If a header is used in a youth class, it may not be the adult riding as passenger.
3. Drivers must wear suitable attire. Men shall wear dress shirt, tie, hat, jackets. Women shall wear dresses, dress pants, skirt, blouse; hat optional. English riding attire is not acceptable.
4. Attendants must be neatly dressed and remain outside the ring except in the event of an emergency or when called to attend their entry.
5. Farm or family name is permitted on the side of a commercial vehicle, but banners advertising farms or associations are not acceptable. No farm name shall be displayed on the clothing of either drivers or attendants.
6. A cart is to be defined as a two-wheeled vehicle not of wire wheeled bicycle type.
7. Youth, 10-18 years of age or under as of January 1 of the current year, may enter ONLY Youth classes.
8. Junior Drivers must be 10-18 years and must be accompanied by an adult who must remain on the seat at all times.
9. **Entries received after AUGUST 8 will be accepted but may not be acknowledged. Post Entries accepted at Regular Fees.**

USE BLUE ENTRY BLANK

To be shown to a suitable working vehicle. To work both ways of the ring at a flat walk. To stand quietly and back readily. May be asked to back the length of the vehicle. A groom will be permitted at the animal's head but should not hold the animal except to control unruliness or to prevent an accident. Fancy equipment not to count over a neat suitable working turnout. Classes to be judged 60% on performance and manners, 20% neatness and appropriateness of equipment and vehicle, 20% conformation and type. Ponies should be of heavy horse type, 60" and under. All ponies entered in the Pony Pairs Classes must be measured by the official Horse Show Steward at 10 AM Thursday in the designated area at the Main Barn. Measuring will be done in accordance with the USEF Rules. The shoe is included in the height of the animal. If either pony exceeds 56", they must be entered in the over 56" class. If the measurement places your team in a different class than entered, the owner must notify the horse show office of the change.

 To be judged both ways of the ring at a walk and jog or trot and to back for the judge. Open to adult and youth riders.
