SPECIFIC POULTRY DEPARTMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The rules printed herein and the Poultry Building General Rules are made a part of the conditions under which all entries of exhibitors are made, and exhibitors are respectfully requested to read them carefully, thereby avoiding confusion at the time of the Fair and to ensure they are entering their exhibit correctly.
2. Animal health regulations listed must be complied with, as well as all general regulations of the Poultry Building in separate file

- Poultry entries will not be accepted for exhibition in 2016 from any state where avian influenza, a serious transmissible disease of poultry, has been diagnosed.

Should this disease appear in a New York flock, as a disease control measure, the New York State Fair Poultry Show may be cancelled.

Your NPIP Pullorum-Typhoid Clean Flock form must be submitted with your entry and a copy must be brought and given to the Poultry Superintendent upon arrival.

Any interpretation of regulations 2 or 3 will be made by the Agricultural Staff of the Fair in consultation with the Director of Animal Industry and the Superintendent of the New York State Fair Poultry Show. Failure to follow animal health regulations may result in forfeiture of premiums and/or suspension from being able to show animals in future years at the NYS Fair.

- Birds will be inspected daily by a veterinarian from the Bureau of Animal Industry, NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets. Birds affected with any contagious disease(s) will be returned to the owner or isolated from the Poultry Building. Birds removed by the veterinarian or birds substituted for birds removed, must be examined by the veterinarian before they are returned to the show.

Driving Instructions for Bringing Birds In: On Tuesday, August 30 from 1 p.m. –5 p.m. Vehicles will be allowed to enter Gate 5, proceed up Rodeo Drive, the lane between the railroad tracks

and State Fair Blvd, enter through Gate 3A which is located just before Pedestrian Gate 3. Enter the Dairy Cattle Barn between the wash racks and manure bin. Subject to vehicle and crowd conditions.

5. **No birds allowed on public buses.**
6. All exhibits **must be out by 12:00 noon** on Tuesday, September 6.
7. **Roosters entered in the Rooster Crowing Contest may stay all 12 days or be brought in daily.**
8. Judging for **First Shift** will be on Saturday, August 27 at 9:00 a.m. and judging for **Second Shift** will be on Friday, September 2 at 9:00 a.m.
9. The exhibitor is responsible to coop in and out their own birds.
10. Before leaving the building – return release form to the Superintendent’s Office.
11. A specimen one year or more in age shall be considered a cock or hen. A specimen under one year of age shall be considered a cockerel or pullet.
12. The American Standard of Perfection and the American Bantam Association Standard will be the guides in judging.
13. All specimens are to be exhibited in their natural condition, except Game and Game Bantams.
14. **Numbered leg banding** required on all runner ducks, pheasants and guinea fowl before cooping. **These classes will not be judged without numbered bands.** We also encourage banding of all entries and recording of the band number on coop tags.
15. **Exhibitors are to report to the Superintendent’s Office for a release form. DO NOT REMOVE COOP TAGS!!** No poultry entries are to be removed from the building until the steward checks them out. Any person violating this above rule automatically forfeits all premiums due.

1. The 2016 NEW YORK STATE FAIR ROOSTER CROWING CONTESTS will be held from 11:00 to 11:15 a.m. AND 4:00 to 4:15 p.m. daily. The finals will be held from 11:00 a.m. to 11:15 a.m. on the last day of the Fair, September 5.
2. The location of the contest will be the Poultry Building by the Waterfowl Pond.
3. The contest is open to the world.
4. Exhibitors who have made entries in the poultry classes will not be required to pay an exhibitor fee. Exhibitors entering **only** the Rooster Crowing Contest will be required to pay the **\$10.00 exhibitor fee and the \$1.00 per class per bird fee**. Check must be sent with entry.
5. Entries must be received by 4:30 p.m., July 11.
6. These animals may stay the entire 12 days **or can be brought in daily**.
7. An exhibitor can enter one rooster in EITHER THE AM OR PM, BUT NOT BOTH each day. The rooster having the most crows on any particular day within the fifteen minutes designated BETWEEN THE DAILY AM WINNER AND THE PM WINNER IS THE DAILY CHAMPION.
8. Only roosters winning first place in daily contests will be eligible to compete in the final.
9. Any ties will be “crowed off” by rules set up by the committee. **Any special cases not covered by the rules will be acted upon by the general committee in charge of the contest.**
10. Judges will be announced by the committee and qualified recorders will be assigned to record the number of crows during the specified time.
11. Roosters will be penned in individual coops and any method may be used to get the bird to crow without touching it. (Talk, gimmick, clap sides with hands, throw food, whistle, etc.)

12. Exhibitors can bring their rooster to compete any day and take their birds home that night or they may leave it for the complete contest.
13. The New York State Fair reserves the right to use the Grand Champion and the Reserve Champion on TV programs or such other publicity purposes as required.
