### **EXHIBITOR GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. The rules printed herein are made a part of the conditions under which all entries of exhibitors are made, and exhibitors are respectfully requested to read them carefully, thereby avoiding confusion at the time of the Fair and to ensure they are entering their exhibit correctly.
2. As a condition of exhibiting at the New York State Fair, the exhibitor authorizes the State Fair to use any photographs from the event for future publication.
3. When entering on line, submit list of possible entries such that the tags are printed out and available upon arrival to the flower show. Alternatively, print out your own tags to fill out at home. Use the Entry List form to catalog what you plan to bring. Additional entries are permitted the morning of the Show.
4. Completely filling out entry tags and correct placement of entries is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Variety name will give you a higher score with the judges. Tags must include exhibitor number, division, and class. See individual premium books for more details regarding each flower show. All tags to be filled out in black or blue ink.
5. The New York State Fair assumes no responsibility for payment of special awards offered by others.
6. While the Management will do everything in its power for the safety and protection of all exhibits, it does not assume responsibility in case of loss or damage to exhibits from any cause. Exhibitor assumes risk associated with, resulting from or arising in connection with exhibitor's participation or presence at the New York State Fair, including, risks of theft, loss, harm or injury to the person, property, whether caused by negligence, intentional act, accident, Act of God or otherwise. Exhibitor has sole responsibility for its property or any theft, damage or other loss to such property, whether or not stored in any courtesy storage areas. The New York State Fair, nor any of their respective officers, directors, employees, representatives or assigns, shall be liable for, and exhibitor hereby releases all of them from, and covenants not to sue any of them with respect to, risks, damages and liability described in this paragraph.
7. Exhibitor must show their exhibit(s) in such a manner as required by the Superintendent in charge of the Department.
8. The decision of the judges shall be final in all cases, except where error, fraud, misrepresentation or collusion, not discovered at the time of the award, is proven. In such cases the Superintendent or such referee as they may appoint may make decisions, or the case may be appealed to the Agriculture Manager, whose decisions shall be final.
9. All entries in the flower shows must be made in the name of their actual growers/producers (exceptions are listed in individual premium books).

10. The right is reserved to withhold the prizes awarded in every case in which it shall appear to the Management that the regulations have not been complied with, or that fraud or deception has been attempted, or where the article is not worthy and its decision shall be final and binding on all parts.
11. No person having entered anything for competition or exhibition may withdraw it after judging; prize cards and ribbons must be displayed during the Fair. Any infraction of these rules will incur the forfeiture of all prizes awarded to the exhibitor, and such further penalty as the Management may impose.

#### **PREMIUM CHECKS AWARDED**

1. Premiums are paid solely from the records of the judge's books. Ribbons or cards have no value as to the payment of premiums.
2. All premium checks not cashed within 60 days of the check's date are void.
