Empire RV Park Terms & Conditions

The New York State Fair Director reserves the final and absolute right to interpret the terms and conditions and to settle and determine all matters, questions or differences in regard to, or otherwise arising out of, connected with, or incidental to the New York State Fair. The Director further reserves the right to determine unforeseen matters not covered by these rules, and to amend or add to these rules, as in his/her judgment he/she may determine necessary.

You will be informed of any instance(s) of non-compliance with these Empire RV Park Terms and Conditions and appropriate action will be taken by NYS Fair Parking Management. The most serious instances of non-compliance will result in revocation of RV parking permits with no refunds and an order to vacate the Fairgrounds immediately.

Reservation Details:

The Empire RV Park reservation includes an RV parking site for up to a 16-night stay (includes water, electric, sewer and garbage pick-up), one vehicle parking permit, and two 12-day admission wristband passes to the Fair. Use fee is \$600 plus a \$9.00 reservation fee per site.

Starting on Thursday, August 25, 2016 at 8:00am, all admission policies are in effect. State Fair admission and special day details will be available on the Fair's website, <http://nysfair.ny.gov>. Regular admission ticket holders may leave and re-enter only upon getting their hand stamped. If you leave and come back another day, you will need to purchase an admission ticket to re-enter the grounds at that time.

Assigned Site Guidelines:

All vehicles should be parked either pulled-in or backed-in, centered on the designated camping site number. All vehicles, tow vehicles, and other items must fit within the assigned RV site and not impose upon neighboring sites or fire lanes - site sizes vary. You must not encroach on the assigned site of another guest with your RV, slide-outs, pop-ups, awnings, grills or furniture. You may not extend beyond the site allotted in any direction, State Fair management are the sole arbiters of whether a vehicle extends beyond the site. Any vehicle causing a disturbance to neighboring sites may be relocated or removed from the property.

The close configuration of RV lots requires that our guests be good neighbors and conduct themselves in a manner that provides for the comfort and enjoyment of all. Your site must be quiet enough not to disturb your closest neighbor from 12:00 midnight to 7:00am. Persons to whom permits are issued, bearers and their guests are expected to be familiar with and abide by these RV Terms and Conditions. The State Fair management reserves the right to deny access to the Empire Park RV lot, or cite and remove any RV in violation of the Empire Park RV Terms and Conditions or any vehicle deemed unacceptable for the RV lot.

Cancellations:

To cancel a reservation prior to your scheduled arrival, you must do so online by logging into your Reserve America account before Sunday, August 21, 2016. To cancel a reservation on Sunday, August 21, 2016 you must contact the Empire RV Park office at (315) 487-7711 ext. 1227. **No refunds will be given after Sunday, August 21, 2016.**

Cancelling 8 days or more prior to arrival - Reservation Fee \$9.00 + Cancellation Fee \$9.00

Cancelling 7 days or less prior to arrival - Reservation Fee \$9.00 + Cancellation Fee \$9.00 + Penalty Fee \$120

Please note: All fees are retained if you fail to arrive and do not inform the park of a cancellation in advance.

Electricity:

You shall only use the electricity that is provided for your respective location. Utility cords must not be placed where vehicles can cross or park on them. If they are, Fair Officials will order them disconnected. Hardwiring into Fair electrical panel boxes is prohibited and will result in revocation of your RV parking permit.

Fires:

Recreational Fires must be contained in a fire pit, ring, or fireplace that is no more than 3 feet round and 2 feet high. Fires cannot be directly next to a camper or under an awning or shelter. A portable fire extinguisher or other approved on-site fire-extinguishing equipment, such as dirt, sand, water barrel, garden hose or water truck, must be available for immediate utilization. State Fair Security and the NYS Office of Fire Prevention and Control will be periodically patrol the camping areas and have the authority to make campers extinguish a fire if it is too big or unsafe. The Solvay Fire Department also has the authority to make campers extinguish a fire.

Golf Carts/All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs):

GOLF CARTS AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ARE PROHIBITED IN THE EMPIRE RV PARK AREAS, EXCEPT FOR CONCESSIONAIRES WHO HAVE OBTAINED PROPER NEW YORK STATE FAIR 2016 GOLF CART CREDENTIALS. ALL OTHERS WILL BE CONFISCATED BY THE NEW YORK STATE POLICE.

Holding Tanks:

For health reasons, all RV's must have their own holding tanks. Hose stations are provided exclusively for filling holding tanks and other temporary service needs.

Inspections:

Fair Officials conduct regular inspections of parking facilities.

Check-In:

Gates open for RVs at 10:00am on Sunday, August 21, 2016 and will remain open 24 hours per day until 11:00pm on Wednesday, August 24, 2016. Regular check-in time, beginning on Thursday, August 25, 2016 and continuing throughout the duration of the Fair, is 8:00am-8:00pm.

The Empire RV Park Staff will affixed your permit to a visible location on your RV and vehicle, then will then direct you to your site.

Check-Out:

All RVs must be checked out and off the premises no later than 4:30pm on Tuesday, September 6, 2016 or they will be towed off the grounds at the owner's expense.

Pets:

Pets or animals of any kind are not allowed in exhibition areas of the Fairgrounds except those involved in exhibitions, demonstrations or those used as licensed service, hearing or guide dogs. Pets are allowed in the Empire RV Park area, provided that they are licensed pursuant to Article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law (dogs only). In addition, all animals in the Empire RV Park area must not be left unattended and properly restrained either by leash or crate. Owners are expected to provide adequate food, water and humane care for animals pursuant to Article 26 of the Agriculture and Markets Law. Animal Control will be called for pets deemed at risk of endangering the welfare of others.

Restrooms/Showers:

Locations are in the east and west ends of the Empire RV Park and adjacent to Gates 10 and 11.

Supply Vehicles:

Supply vehicles are prohibited in the Empire RV Park.

Tents:

Tenting is prohibited in the Empire RV Park.

Trash:

All trash must be placed in plastic trash bags. All areas must be kept free of trash. Trash receptacles and dumpsters will be provided.
