ARTS & CRAFTS RULES:

1. Please see the **Creative Arts Center General Rules and Regulations** and the **Creative Arts Center Exhibitor Schedule** that is on the NYS Fair website under Creative Arts Center. **NOTE:** The Exhibitor Schedule contains all dates that pertain to entering and exhibiting in the **NYS Fair Creative Arts Center**.
2. The rules printed herein are made a part of the conditions under which all entries of exhibitors are made, and exhibitors are respectfully requested to read them carefully, thereby avoiding confusion at the time of the competition and to make certain in which classes their entries belong.
3. Please note that each Division may have their own rules that pertain only to that Division and Classes.
4. You may enter multiple times in a division, but **ONLY** one (1) entry may be made in a class unless otherwise stated. The **ONLY** exception to this is the Division for Baby and Division of Gratitude. You may enter a max. of three (3) entries in these Divisions. There is no entry fee for these Divisions. **NOTE:** If you enter as either a Youth or a Senior, you cannot enter as an Adult. The only **EXCEPTION** to this rule is if you are entering something that is not listed in those individual divisions. These divisions are also judged separately.
5. Exhibitor (Entry) Tags: You will receive your entry tag(s) when you drop off your item on receiving day(s). If you would like to share any personal information about your article, please bring it with you on a 3 x 5 index card. This can be attached with your

entry tag. You will be responsible for attaching the tag to your entry on receiving day(s). Please try to attach all tags in the upper right-hand corner of your item(s). Please remember to remove your entry claim stub. If your entry is mailed in, the Arts & Crafts Dept. staff will assist with this.

6. **NEW!** Mailed in entries **MUST BE RECEIVED BY August 5, 2026**. Please mail early. All mailed entries must contain a **New York State Fair Shipping Form and Entry Label**. This form is located on our website as a printout.
7. Selected Division/Class are solely the decision and choice of the exhibitor. The Fair Staff or Judges will not be responsible for selecting appropriate Division/Class entries. Entries not properly entered in the correct Division/Class may not be accepted.
8. The emphasis will be on high quality workmanship, combined with the principles of good design, form, line texture, color, etc. No kits, commercial patterns, sets, or plastic canvas unless designated in the Division/Class. Credit **MUST** be given to the Designer.
9. Entries that are soiled, covered in pet hair, well-worn, pilled, or emitting an unpleasant odor, will be disqualified.
10. **NOTIFICATION:** Exhibitors will receive an email(s) notifying you if your entry(s) was “Accepted” or “Not Accepted” by 4:00 pm Friday following judging days. If you have not received an email by Monday, August 17, you may call the Creative Arts Center Office at 315-728-4328 or email Yvonne.bakowski2@agriculture.ny.gov to verify the status of your entry(s). **PLEASE NOTE** that results will **NOT** be given. **NEW!** **Non-Accepted Pick-Up Day is now on Tuesday, August 18 from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. All entries not picked up on that day will be put in storage until after the fair.**
11. **NEW!** Photos will be allowed to be taken in the Arts & Crafts Exhibition during the New York State Fair. If you would like your entry to be exempt from this, please complete and return the “**No Photo Consent Form**” when you drop off your entry. This can be found on our website as a printout or please ask a staff member for a copy.
12. There will be a “Best in Division” awarded amongst the Blue-Ribbon winners in each Division where applicable. If no Blue ribbons are awarded in a division, then no “Best of Division” ribbon will be awarded. Each Division winner will receive an additional ribbon. Each of the “Best in Division” award winners will compete for the “Director’s Award”.

QUILT/BLANKET OF GRATITUDE RULES:

1. There is **NO** entry fee for this Division.
2. All entries must be hand or machine sewn, knitted, or crocheted by the exhibitor.
3. All entries must have a minimum size of 55" x 65" and a maximum size of 72" x 90".
These quilts/blankets will be given to adults.
4. Entries for this competition should have a patriotic theme (Ex. red, white, & blue colors).
Blocks and patterns of any design are acceptable. Please no wreaths or flowers.
5. Please no military branch specifics (Ex. Army, Navy etc.) We do not know the recipients.
6. The entry can be labeled in the following manor:
 - Quilt of Gratitude
 - Blanket of Gratitude
7. Maximum three (3) entries per person.
8. Use and care information for the quilt/blanket must be included with the entry.
9. This Division is **NOT** eligible for the “Directors Award”.

The New York State Fair invites all New Yorkers to design and create a baby quilt/blanket for this special competition. These Quilts/Blankets will be donated to local charities/organizations after the New York State Fair.

BABY QUILT/BLANKET RULES:

1. There is **NO** entry fee for this Division.
2. All entries must be hand or machine sewn, knitted, or crocheted by the exhibitor.
3. All entries must have a minimum size of 24" x 24" and a maximum size of 45" x 54".
4. Entries must be safe for children to use and play with. No removable choke hazards (i.e., no small pieces that could be swallowed).
5. Maximum three (3) entries per person.
6. Use and care information for the quilt/blanket must be included with the entry.
7. This Division is **NOT** eligible for the “Directors Award”.

Please Note: A Quilt consists of three (3) layers: a Quilt Top, Batting, and Backing. **ALL ENTRIES MUST HAVE A HANGING SLEEVE (NO PINS).** Sleeves must go one (1") inch in from edge on each side, one (1") inch edge at the top of the entry and be five (5") inches in width unless otherwise specified. **MAXIMUM LENGTH** of all quilts is 115" unless otherwise specified.
