Standard Show Classifications
Purebred Shorthorns

All cattle must be purebred to be eligible to show.

In order for an exhibitor to be eligible to receive the American Shorthorn Association's (ASA) share of the premiums at ASA supported shows, the owner's entire herd must be enrolled in the Shorthorn Performance Records (SPR) Program and each animal shown must have individual SPR records.

No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.

All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records of the ASA by the time of the Fair or show.

Individual animals shown in all of the group classes listed below must have been entered and shown in one of the following classes for single animals. Multiple owned animals must be exhibited in the name of all owners.

Family bred and raised animals entered by juniors in Junior Classes and subsequently entered in Open classes may be treated as family entries in group classes.

All Shorthorns and Polled Shorthorns are subject to a tattoo inspection by representatives of the ASA. All Shorthorns and Polled Shorthorns are also subject to an age inspection if deemed necessary by the ASA and the **decision of the examining veterinarian is final.** Use of artificial fins on show animals is not permitted.

IMPORTANT: Each of the following classes **MAY** be broken into multiple classes to accommodate large numbers of entries, but separate classes **MAY NOT** be combined into one. RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All animals to be eligible for an Open Charolais Breeding Class must be purebred and registered with the American-International Charolais Association (AICA). Only bona fide (original certificates of registration will be accepted as evidence of registration and ownership. **NO PHOTOCOPIES.**
2. An animal is eligible to enter or compete in an open Charolais breeding class if registered in country of origin outside the United States and is eligible for purebred registry in the AICA Herdbook.
3. Animals registered in the AICA Colored Division Registry (QF and QM initialed registration numbers) must meet the parameters of the AICA Color Card.
4. All animals are subject to a medical examination in order to determine age, and each animal will be present in the show ring in its natural conformation without alteration or modification. Use of artificial tailheads is not permitted.
5. Any animal not having a legible tattoo or firebrand number is ineligible and will be barred from showing.
6. **NURSE COWS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
7. Cow-Calf: Calf must be cow's natural calf, not embryo transplant. Calf to be no more than 250 days of age by day of show. Calf must be purebred and registered with the AICA. No age restriction on the cow. Cow and/or Calf may be included in group class entries as an individual not as pair compromising a single animal entry.
8. Cow/calf pairs are not eligible for Grand or Reserve Champion Female as a separate Grand and Reserve Champion Heifer is set aside for Cow/Calf.
9. Calves apart of a Cow/Calf pair can be shown in individual age-appropriate classes.
10. AICA requires that all animals be shown with a halter and suggest that all bulls be shown with nose lead.
11. **Article XV, Paragraph 8, Point 2:** "Each animal will be present in its natural conformation and structure without alteration or modification. Alteration or modification shall be defined to include any surgical,

chemical, electrical, or other (including banding or other circulatory construction) appearance change for cosmetic purpose, save only branding, tattooing, foot trimming or dehorning. The act of artificially filling animals internally, which would include stomach pumping, drench tubes, or any other method per (by esophagus) is prohibited. Silicone injection or other injection for cosmetic purpose shall be prohibited. Anabolic steroid use shall likewise be prohibited and any animal testing positive for anabolic steroid or diuretic use shall be presumed to be altered and modified.”

12. All Rules and Regulations apply including those set forth by the New York State Fair.

13. PREMIER BREEDER and PREMIER EXHIBITOR awards will be given on the point system as follows: 3 pts. for 1st prize; 2 pts. for 2nd prize and 1 pt. for 3rd prize. 3 pts. for Grand Champion and 2 pts. for Reserve Grand Champion NO points for Divisional Champions or Reserve Champions. Points will be given on eight head only. Group Classes included, using the same scoring system.

Tie Breaker: Exhibitor with the most points won by animals bred and owned in individual classes.

All animals must be registered in the American Hereford Association or American Polled Hereford Assoc.; original registration certificates must be presented upon request of Show Officials or AHA Staff.

Animals must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership name or co-owners' names as of show entry deadline date. Ear tattoos must be legible and correct for show eligibility.

Violation of AHA's rules regarding defects and unethical practices will result in disqualification of animals in question.

All other rules of this Show apply.

These rules are specific and clear. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make himself familiar with them. They must be complied with.

GENERAL RULES

- A. **RECORD OF REGISTRY:** Registration in the American Hereford Association is required of all Herefords owned by and to be exhibited by American breeders, whether the animals were domestically produced or of foreign origin. Herefords originating outside the United States and owned by breeders living outside the USA must be registered in the recognized herd or stud book of the country of origin and recognized by the American Hereford Association, or registered in the AHA.
- B. **REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES:** Exhibitors are required to have AHA original registration certificates of the animals on exhibit, in possession of the herdsman with the cattle. Similarly, in cases of animals originating from outside the USA and owned by breeders outside the USA, official registration certificates from country of origin are required. It is required that original registration certificates be current and accurate with regard to the animal's recorded ownership as of the show's entry deadline date. Original registration certificates are to be made available on request to staff.
- C. **REGISTRATION STATUS:** Application for registration must be on file with AHA by that specific show's entry deadline date for an animal to be eligible for that specific show.
- D. **IDENTIFICATION BY TATTOO:** Ear tattoos must be clearly legible and agree with animal's registration certificate. Any animal whose tattoos do not match the registration certificate is ineligible to be exhibited in that show at which detection is made.
- E. **OWNERSHIP:** Cattle must be entered and exhibited under the recorded ownership as of the show's entry deadline date. (See Rule "G" also.)
- F. **NEW OWNERS:** Transfers of ownership must be on file in the AHA office no later than the show's entry deadline date.
- G. **JOINTLY OWNED ANIMALS:** Jointly owned animals must be entered and exhibited under the joint ownership in the individual heifer and bull classes.
- H. **GROUP CLASSES:**
 - (1) Jointly owned animals must be shown in the Group Classes by one of the co-owners under his banner, or may be shown in this class under the joint ownership if all animals are owned alike.
 - (2) A common ownership of all four animals in the Get-of-Sire Classes is not required; they may be solely owned or jointly owned by different breeder-exhibitors, but get-of-sire entry may be entered/exhibited in the name of only one herd.
- I. **DEFECTS AND UNETHICAL PRACTICES:** The following are considered defects and unethical practices. Any violation of the rules regarding these will result in disqualification of the animal in question:
 - (1) Removing, trimming or tampering with scurs, or any animal that is not a naturally polled animal.
 - (2) Cutting out, dyeing or otherwise tampering with any white hairs, constituting what is known as a lineback on the back of any animal.
 - (3) Application of hair or artificial foundation in any area of the animal to alter the appearance of the natural lines of structure of the animal.
 - (4) Application of dye or coloring to hair of any animal in any area of its body that would change natural color or color marking/pattern of animal.

- J. **SIFTING:** All cattle entered for show may be inspected and required to meet minimum standards of type, quality and conformation.
- K. **BEST SIX HEAD:** Exhibitors who make entries in the Best Six Head Class are required to lead out in this class, or forfeit their premium money, providing they have at least six animals in the event.
- L. **SENIOR YEARLING HEIFERS:** In shows after January 1, senior yearling age heifers (calved Aug. 1-Dec. 31) are required to be exhibited in show ring competition with their own natural calf (not embryo transplant) at foot.
- M. **CALVES SHOWN WITH DAMS:** A calf exhibited in show ring competition with its dam, in any class, is eligible to compete in an individual calf class by itself in the same show, and vice versa.

Rules Specific to the Belted Galloway Show

Sanctioned by the US Belted Galloway Society, Inc.

1. **Registration.** Animals must be registered in the US Belted Galloway Society, Inc. Herd Book or recorded in the Appendix or Canadian Belted Galloway Association Herd Book. Animals must be properly marked, in good physical condition, and typical of the breed in conformation. Good physical condition shall include, but not be limited to, the absence of any infectious condition such as ringworm or warts.
2. **Papers and Tattoos.** Original registration papers will be required to check in. A superintendent or breed representative must be able to identify a match between the animal's tattoos(s) and registration papers. Animals without a visible tattoo or with a tattoo that does not match the corresponding registration paper, will not be allowed to show.
3. **Animal Security.** Unattended animals must be double-tied with halters, neck ropes or two halters/two neck ropes.
4. **Unethical Fitting.** The show committee reserves the right to disqualify any animal that has been fitted in an unethical manner. Unethical fitting shall include, but not limited to: Any injections of gas, solid or liquid under the skin to alter conformation; any additions of artificial tail heads or polls; surgical alteration of the animal's shape; dyeing or coloring which alters the animal's natural color pattern. Artificially fitting animals internally (pumping) is strictly prohibited.
5. **Date of Ownership.** Must be dated at least 30 days prior to the show.
6. **Interference with Judge.** Interference with or disrespect to the judge by an exhibitor during the performance of his/her duties shall be deemed grounds for immediate disqualification and subject to further sanctions, as detailed in the World Beef Expo General Rules & Regulations.
7. **Qualification of Bulls.** In order to compete in bull classes, each bull must have two visible and descended testicles. No cryptorchids will be allowed to compete.
8. **Exhibitor Compliance.** Exhibitors are expected to comply with all rules and regulations of the US Belted Galloway Society, Inc. and of the World Beef Expo, or be subject to the consequences as identified in those rules and regulations.

In the group classes, jointly owned animals may be entered and exhibited under the name of one of the co-owners provided he owns a full or part interest in each of the animals in the group entry. Individual animals shown in all group classes listed below, except the Cow-Calf Class, must have been entered and shown in one of the following classes for individual animals. For group classes, except the Get-of-Sire Class and Produce of Dam, all individual animals making up a group entry must be owned or co-owned by the exhibitor and each exhibitor can only have one entry in each group class (other than Get & Produce). All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records of the American Simmental Association or Canadian Simmental Association as evidenced by the ORIGINAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in individual classes, and for the purposes of calculating Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder, the points are attributable to the multi-ownership (all co-owners) not to the individual co-owners. In the group classes, jointly owned animals may be entered and exhibited under the name of one of the co-owners provided he owns a full or part interest in each of the animals in the group entry. Individual animals shown in all group classes listed below, except the Cow-Calf Class, must have been entered and shown in one of the following classes for individual animals.
