SPECIFIC CAVY DEPARTMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Due to space limitations, there will be a cap on Cavy entries. Entries over the limit will be subject to restrictions at the discretion of the Superintendent. (No additional passes will be given for entries over 41 animals.)
2. The rules printed herein and the Poultry Building General Rules are made a part of the conditions under which all entries of exhibitors are made, and exhibitors are respectfully requested to read them carefully, thereby avoiding confusion at the time of the Fair and to ensure they are entering their exhibit correctly.
3. Animal health regulations listed must be complied with, as well as all general regulations of the Poultry Building in separate file. All entries are subject to general rules and Animal health regulations listed in the poultry building general rules.
4. The Fair reserves the right to add or substitute judges if conditions warrant.
5. The greatest possible care will be given to all exhibits, but the Management will not be responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage that occurs, the specimens being entered at the sole risk of the owner. Competent personnel will be in attendance day and night and the Management will do all in its power for the safety and protection of the exhibits. Each specimen must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
6. At check-in, all animals must meet the minimum weight requirement, as set forth by the ARBA standard and any diseased or injured animals will be rejected and sent home upon request of the management.
7. Cavies must be checked in at front table. Cavies **must** have the approved ear tag in the **left ear**. This is an ARBA Rule. Any animal not permanently marked will be rejected at check-in.
8. Officials & Superintendent reserve the right to limit exhibitors and/or entries for space and safety compliance.
9. 4-H'ers must let the Superintendent know which cavies will be shown in the 4-H Show. This includes animals used for the Decathlon event.
10. Animals entered in the show may be sold only if the animals are judged, but cannot leave the Building until exhibits are released or by permission of the Superintendent. Please pick up statement of additional rules regarding sales upon check-in.

11. **There will be no sale signs permitted on the coops.** Any exhibitor wishing to sell animals must provide a legible list to the. List must contain the Exhibitor name, phone number, coop number and sale price. Only the Superintendent or an appointed Official State Fair Staff member shall maintain the sales board and process any and all sales. Exhibitors may NOT alter the sales boards or conduct any sales on behalf of the Fair, NYS Old Timer's Club or themselves.
12. Express shipments will not be accepted. Any animal entered in the show and placed for sale cannot be sold from home or directly through exchange between the exhibitor and buyer. All sales must have an official receipt made by designated show official, Superintendent or Stat Fair Staff member. Should you violate this rule, you will **NOT** be allowed to sell animals for one year.
13. Ribbons and specials must be picked up on closing day.
14. To compete for display prizes, exhibitors must exhibit at least ten single entries.
15. Specials received too late for publication in the Premium Book will be posted in the showroom. Specials offered by individuals or clubs will not be guaranteed by New York State Fair but all are believed to be bona fide offers.
