SPECIFIC RULES FOR ROSE SHOW

1. The rules printed herein and the flower show general rules are made a part of the conditions under which all entries of exhibitors are made, and exhibitors are respectfully requested to read them carefully, thereby avoiding confusion at the time of the Fair and to ensure that all entries are in the appropriate class.
2. Exhibitors should file a complete list of possible entries when submitting entry form to allow entry tags to be printed. Additional entries are permitted the morning of the Show.
3. Roses exhibited in horticultural classes must have been grown out of doors in the Exhibitor's Private Garden.
4. Containers will be provided for all entries in horticultural classes.
5. Only one exhibitor per variety allowed from a garden.
6. ONE BLOOM PER STEM entries must be shown disbudded (no side buds allowed). A SPRAY must have at least two blooms.
7. When a named variety class exists, a rose must be entered in that class.
8. Multiple entries are permitted in color classes or type of rose classes, provided that each entry is a different named variety.
9. All entries must follow the classification of Roses as found in the American Rose Society's 2022 Handbook for Selecting Roses and Modern Roses XII.
10. Judging of exhibits will be conducted in accordance with American Rose Society standards. Decisions of the judges are final.

SCALE OF POINTS FOR JUDGES AND EXHIBITORS

The official point scoring system of the American Rose Society is:

Form.....	25 points
Substance	15 points
Color	20 points
Stem and Foliage.....	20 points
Balance and Proportion.....	10 points
Size.....	10 points

A typical blue ribbon winner will have symmetrical form, bright coloration, healthy foliage, fresh petals, good size, and a stem length sufficient to give a pleasing proportion to the size of the bloom. At the time of judging the rose should be at its most perfect phase of possible beauty, neither a tight bud nor full-blown bloom.

In addition to the Rules of the New York State Fair, the rules of the American Rose Society apply to this division. Exhibitors entering the show agree to abide by these rules:

1. Entrants must notify entry department if withdrawal is necessary. After August 1, the entrant is responsible to find a replacement.
2. While judging is in progress, ONLY judges and clerks will be allowed on the show floor. **All exhibitors must be off the floor promptly at 10:45 AM.** Judging will begin at 11:00 AM.
3. Exhibits must remain in place until the end of the show. **Exhibitors are responsible for removal of exhibits at the end of the show.**
4. Judging will be according to the American Rose Society system of scoring; 1 first place, 90 points or higher; 1 second place, 85 points or higher; 1 third place, 80 points or higher, 1 or more honorable mention if merited.
5. A covered background and underlay **are required** in all classes and **are to be provided** by the exhibitor.
6. All roses must be outdoor garden grown and must be of high quality.
7. A rose or roses must be the dominant flower in all arrangements.
8. The ARS approved exhibition name for all roses used **must be listed on the back of the entry tag.**
9. “AG” must be written on the entry tag if roses are arranger-grown so that the entry will be eligible for ARS medal certificates.
10. Accessories may be used. A card of intent may be included with an arrangement as an explanation of the arranger’s interpretation of the theme or class title.
11. Flowers other than roses, and dried and/or treated dried plant material are allowed.
12. An arrangement incorrectly placed in a class will be judged in the class in which it is placed.

13. All entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
14. No one but the exhibitor may touch or move an arrangement. However, in special circumstances, if all efforts to locate the arranger have failed, the arrangement chair may carefully move an arrangement.

Infringement of the following rules will result in severe penalty:

1. The use of plant material on the NYS Conservation list is not permitted.
2. Painted or dyed fresh plant materials and live creatures are not allowed.
3. The American flag or flag of any country is not to be used.

Bravery and strength are needed to overcome obstacles, save the day or become a champion. Design not to exceed – 10” wide, 10” deep, 10” high. Eligible for: ARS Miniature Gold Medal Certificate, ARS Miniature Royalty Award

Class 482 – “Honoring the Creative Women”

Designer’s Choice of style, which must be noted on entry tag. Honoring creative women. From literature to the visual or the performing arts, we honor women throughout history who made their mark through creative works.. Design must be larger than 10”, but no greater than 20” in height, width or depth. No accessories allowed. Eligible for: ARS Gold, Silver or Bronze Medal Certificate, ARS Duke of Arrangements Award.

Class 483 – “The Innovative Woman”

A Modern Design (designer to note type of modern design on entry tag. We honor the women throughout history who have broken the mold, gone against the grain and invented, developed innovations or idea or rebelled in order to move society forward. Maximum space allowed – 24” wide, 24” deep, 36” high. Eligible for: ARS Gold, Silver or Bronze Medal Certificate, ARS Artist Award.

Personal Adornments. We honor the women who are forever immortalized by their style, look or fashion. A Chaplet, Hat, Bridesmaid’s bouquet, Nosegay or Corsage. Item may be displayed hanging on a background or stand or mounted on a mount (EX a milliner’s stand). Maximum space allowed – 24” wide, 24” deep, 36” high. Eligible for: ARS Gold, Silver or Bronze Medal Certificate, ARS Oriental Award
