

Labor: Some of the duties include; cleaning of the grounds, basic painting duties, sweeping sidewalks, raking and planting.

General Mechanic: You **must** meet the following minimum qualifications in order to be considered for this job position:

Four years of full-time experience in a trade under a skilled journey-level position which would provide training equivalent to that given in an apprenticeship program. Apprentice training in a trade or training gained by the completion of technical courses in a trade at a school, institute or branch of the Armed Services may be substituted for the above experience on a year-for-year basis.

Clerical: Some of the duties include; typing, filing, answering telephones, using a computer.

Security: Some of the duties include; directing vehicle and pedestrian traffic, ensuring safety of Fairgoers, monitoring the interior and exterior of buildings.

Potato Booth: Some of the duties include; cleaning, prepping, baking and serving potatoes.

Labor/Maintenance/Restrooms: Some of the duties include; emptying trash cans, sweeping and mopping floors, cleaning restrooms (toilets, sinks, countertops, floors).

Parking: Responsible for delivering friendly, quality customer service to Fairgoers while receiving payment for parking or facilitating the flow of traffic through the parking lots and directing Fairgoers into a parking space.

Gate Attendant: Some of the duties include: using a computer or scanner to take admission tickets or other credentials from individuals attending the State Fair.

Gate Cashier: Some of the duties include: handling all aspects of ticket sales including cash/credit responsibilities as well as customer service.

Guest Relations: Some of the duties include: answering Fairgoer's questions, responding to Fairgoer's needs, promoting the Fair's events, and assist the Fairgoer in a professional, courteous manner.

Trams: Some of the duties include: Driving a truck or tractor that pulls a trolley that Fairgoer's ride on; a driver must be at least 18 years old and possess a valid driver license.

Agriculture Superintendent: Some of the duties include; supervising animal shows, exhibitors, exhibits, employees and independent contractors in an assigned Department.

Agriculture Worker: Some of the duties include; assisting with animal shows by sweeping aisles, removing manure, helping exhibitors carry in feed and tack, opening and closing gates during animal shows.
