RULES AND REGULATIONS

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY THESE RULES ARE PART OF THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH ALL ENTRIES ARE MADE.

“Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith”.

Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant

Safe Sport Reminder

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Effective immediately, any competition with the start date of September 1, 2020 and later will be required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: **Reminder:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

HORSE IDENTIFICATION

All Horses showing on USEF days must have USHJA # on the entry form or apply for one at the show. **Per HU104** All horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity. Horses can be microchipped at the Horse Show.

BACK NUMBERS

A number will be assigned to each horse when the entry is made. This number must be displayed whenever the horse is shown. Non showing horses must be entered in the horse show office. individual riding or handling. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the area. **Per HJ106.2** . All entered horses in the schooling area or warm-up area must have its show number attached to the horse or the rider/handler. Non Showing horses must be entered through the horse show office and all entry blanks and waivers must be signed.

AMATEUR

All exhibitors in Amateur Sections must present amateur certification at the Show Office before numbers can be picked up.

MEASUREMENTS

Horses and Ponies showing in any pony sections or Large Junior Hunter sections must possess a measurement card. All animals that do not have a current measurement card can be measured at the horse show 9am Tuesday. Please let *LIZ* know if you have a pony or horse that needs to be measured.

NOTATIONS

Per HU118.3 Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance in rated sections. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

On show days schooling will be controlled if necessary and courtesy circles will be limited and or the dotted linen rule will be

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES

PER GR821 Riders showing in opportunity classes/sections are not permitted to cross-enter into any non-opportunity classes. Horses may cross-enter into non-opportunity classes.

ENTRIES

Management reserves the right to limit courtesy circles and to conduct any class in an alternate location.

LUNGING

Lunging is only permitted in the warm up ring during **NON SHOW HOURS**. During Show hours lunging is permitted in the "Woodmiser" Ring. Lunging is **NEVER PERMITTED** in the Coliseum.

STABLING

STABLING : Limited Stabling Is Available at the New York State Fair. Stall Fees: \$50.00 for the for permanent/temporary box stalls (10'x10') with doors with concrete floors. **Bedding not included but is available for purchase on the grounds.** No alterations of stalls will be permitted.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

Motorized Vehicle Statement : Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Exhibitors are not permitted to bring Golf Carts, Scooters, Gaiters, ATV's or any farm type utility vehicles on to the grounds.

Move In & Out

Vehicle access to the horse barns will be restricted to 11pm-11am from 8/26-9/7. Please reach out to Liz with any questions.

EXHIBITOR RV PARKING

Temporary RV parking must be requested on line. Please note that all RV parking for exhibitors in the Toyota Coliseum area will be located across State Fair Blvd in the Pink Lot. (See Map) All RV parking is nonrefundable. All In the Main Barn area, RV units will be accommodated in the Pink parking lot. Tow vehicles may remain attached, in most instances. Directions for access to the parking area will be sent with the stickers. Spaces will be numbered and exhibitors will be assigned a specific space. Temporary RV spaces include electricity, water and sewage pump outs. The Pink RV Lot has enhanced electrical services and a shower and rest room facility. Pump outs are included in the parking fee. Gate 4 will remain open 24 hours a day, every day, for access to the horse barn area. Exhibitors with campers will be issued passes for easy access through Gate 4 by surrendering their passes in the downstairs show office. Exhibitors stabling in the race barns will be assigned temporary RV parking in the Green area. These RVs may arrive at any hour and will be able to leave tow vehicles attached. Hookups in this area include sewers. Spaces will be allocated on a first-come basis by the Superintendent. Requests will not be honored unless approved by the Superintendent. Any changes must be approved by the Superintendent.

STABLING

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Temporary and permanent stabling. All horses shown must be stabled. No doors shall be removed from a box stall or stalls altered in any manner by an exhibitor. Stall assignments will be made by the Superintendent. Special requests or changes must be approved by LIZ PINTO stabling but management DOES NOT GUARANTEE that all requests will be honored and will not consider unfilled requests a bona fide reason for cancellation and/or refund.

BLOCK STABLING

Individuals and members of larger stables wishing to stable together must send entries together and clearly indicate with whom the entry should be stabled. Otherwise, management will not be responsible for these requests. Space is provided on the entry blank for indicating with whom such exhibitors will stable. TACK STALLS may be limited. Exhibitors sharing a tack stall must submit their entries together.

All Horses Coming To The Main Barns Will Enter Gate 7, Turn Left and Drive To The Barns. After Unloading, Ask For Directions To The Black Lot.

All Paperwork Will Be Checked & Verified In the Horse Show Office. No Numbers Will Be Released Until The Proper Paperwork Is On File In The Show Office.

Exhibitors may have to secure a release from the show office prior to removing their horses from the grounds.

HORSE HEALTH INFORMATION

ALL COGGINS PAPERS MUST ACCOMPANY ANIMALS ON TO THE GROUNDS.

All New York State horses must have had a Coggins test in calendar year 2025 or 2026.

All out-of-state horses must have had a Coggins test with one (1) year entry into New York State. All out-of-state horses must also have CURRENT INTERSTATE HEALTH PAPERS, DATED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE HORSES' ENTRY INTO NEW YORK STATE. HEALTH PAPERS MUST BE WITH THE HORSE AND PRESENTED AT THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE UPON ARRIVAL.

All Animals 105 days of age or older on the date of arrival at the fair must be vaccinated for rabies. The vaccine must be administered at least 14 days prior to arrival on the fairgrounds but no greater than the labeled

time specified for active protection against rabies. The animal's rabies vaccination status must remain current throughout its stay on the fairgrounds.

Booster Vaccination: Animals previously vaccinated for rabies but whose vaccine status has expired, are eligible for exhibition upon receiving a booster vaccination. This booster must be given at least **3 days prior** to arrival at the Fair. **Proof of previous vaccination is REQUIRED.**

PARKING

EXHIBITOR RV PARKING

Temporary RV parking must be requested on line. Please note that all RV parking for exhibitors in the Toyota Coliseum area will be located across State Fair Blvd in the Pink Lot. (See Map) All RV parking is nonrefundable. All In the Main Barn area, RV units will be accommodated in the Pink parking lot. Tow vehicles may remain attached, in most instances. Directions for access to the parking area will be sent with the stickers. Spaces will be numbered and exhibitors will be assigned a specific space. EXHIBITOR PASSES

Exhibitor passes will be emailed to the owners, as submitted online, for the days that their horses are showing.

VETERINARIAN

The Official Veterinarians reside are designated to make official inspections and rulings in all cases where the opinion of a Veterinarian is required. In addition, they may be contacted through the Barn Office whenever you require their services.

HORSE VEHICLE PARKING

All Horse Transport Trucks and Trailers must park in the Black Livestock Trailer lot .

Horse trailers carrying horses , that arrive between 11pm and 11 AM, must enter through Gate 7. After unloading horses, exit Gate #7 (get hand stamped for re-entry) and enter Gate #7. Go straight down the perimeter road and follow signs to Livestock Vehicle Parking. Between 11 PM and 8 AM, enter gate 7 and then enter the Fairgrounds at Gate 11.

Horse vehicles will NOT have to drive through the heaviest pedestrian traffic areas on their way to and/or from the barns. ***The Livestock Vehicle parking area will be supervised to facilitate organized parking that will keep all vehicles accessible at all times.***

Post Entries

Prize Money

Premium checks are made payable to, and are mailed to, the owners of the horses as stated on the entry blank. Premium vouchers will not be processed without owners' SFS#, full addresses and email addresses.

Office Fee

Every horse will be charged a \$30.00 Non-refundable Office Fee. (\$15 Exhibitor Fee & \$15 Processing Fee)

Motorized Vehicles

Exhibitors are not permitted to bring and operate any type of motorized vehicle (golf carts, scooters, gators, etc.)

Entries

If horses are entered and not exhibited, stall fees will be forfeited. The management reserves the right to decline any entry without being liable for compensation of any kind. All entries must be made by exhibitor or his authorized agent, and no animal will be admitted or stabled unless properly entered. Exhibitors or their agent are responsible for the accuracy of their entries. Errors, omissions or substitutions must be reported before the show starts to avoid post entry fees. The horse show will not be responsible for exhibitors losing points because their entries are not complete.

Refunds

REFUNDS: No refunds will be made without approval of management and Audit & Control. All refunds must be requested and all paper work supporting the request must be delivered to the horse show secretary before 10 AM on 8/25. No refunds on stalls. In the event that a horse is scratched, the stall reverts to the show and under no circumstances may be sold or reassigned without management approval. There will be a \$50.00 processing charge for all scratches after the closing date. REFUNDS OF ENTRIES ONLY for the bona fide reasons (i.e. illness of exhibitor and/or horses verified by medical or veterinarian's certificate) must be requested and all paper work supporting the request must be delivered to the horse show secretary before 10 AM on 8/28.

Add/Scratches

All scratches must be made with LIZ two hours prior to the start of the session.

Adds must be made the day prior to the scheduled class

The exhibitors and spectators shall hold them harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings arising from any accident damages.
